



GCSE RESULTS 2017

96 students: 51 boys, 45 girls

Students achieving at least 5 A*-C grades incl English and Maths at 4+	66%
Attainment 8 Score	42.92
Students achieving at least a 4 in English and Maths	69%
Students achieving at least a 5 in English and Maths	45%
Students achieving the EBacc	28%
Entries resulting in at least a Grade A/7	13%
Entries resulting in at least a Grade C/4	70%

Notes:

The majority of subjects are now graded 1 to 9 with a 4 equivalent to a C and designated as a Standard Pass. A grade 5 is equivalent to the top part of a C grade or the lower end of a B grade and is designated as a Strong Pass.

The EBacc – this measure recognises students who achieve at least a C or 4 in all of:- English, Maths, Science, a Language, History or Geography.

A8 score – the total point score achieved by students on average. This is calculated by adding up the points for their best 6 subjects plus English and Maths whose scores are doubled.
