*Not yet published. However, the figure quoted is accurate based on data provided by Shropshire Council. The DfE published figure does not currently include students who have progressed to post-16 education beyond England (a high percentage of our students opt to study in Wales) so may appear significantly lower than this.

Notes:

All GCSE subjects are graded 1 to 9 with a 4 equivalent to a C and designated as a Standard Pass. A grade 5 is equivalent to the top part of a C grade or the lower end of a B grade and is designated as a Strong Pass.

The EBacc – this measure recognises students who achieve at least a pass in all of English, Maths, Science, a Language, History or Geography

A8 score – the point score achieved by students on average across their best 8 subjects. This is calculated by adding up the points for their best 6 subjects plus English and Maths whose scores are double-weighted.
